The infrastructure of the college is well maintained with the integrated effort of the college campus owner (Deepshikha Kala Sansthan), staff members, students and external agencies.

student initiative

1. Class representative (Student Council) Cleanliness of the class is ensured under a point system with each class competing for the best class award for Civic Sense.
2. Full-time computer system administrators, gardeners, housekeeping staff and security guards, lab attendants assist in effective maintenance and upkeep of the facilities. Some of the support staff employed by the college are also trained in electrical and plumbing work to deal with any immediate emergency.

External Agencies:

1. Annual Maintenance Contract Regular maintenance of infrastructure and various equipment is ensured.
2. Carpenters, electricians, masons, construction workers, plumbers and painters are available on call.
3. Painting, repair and renovation work is done regularly.

4. The service of a professional computer technician is available to maintain and upgrade the IT infrastructure.
5. A high-end UPS is purchased to provide protection and backup facility to various electrical equipment.
6. A special power line and three-phase power connection ensures uninterrupted power supply. In case of power failure, a generator facility is available in the college.
7. Continuous and adequate water supply is available in the college campus. Water purifiers connected to hot/cold/warm temperature coolers have been installed for safe drinking water.
8. Water tanks are also cleaned regularly

Student-centered education is an approach to education that focuses on the needs of the individual learner. This type of learning puts the student at the center of the learning process and gives them a voice in what they are learning. In a student-centered classroom, the teacher is more of a facilitator than a lecturer. This learning environment allows students to be more engaged and take ownership of their education.
