OBJECTIVE OF THE CREATIVITY ACTIVITY

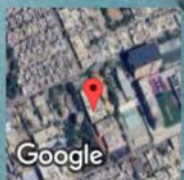

Rules of paper bag making activity :-

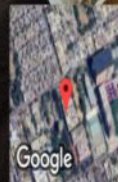
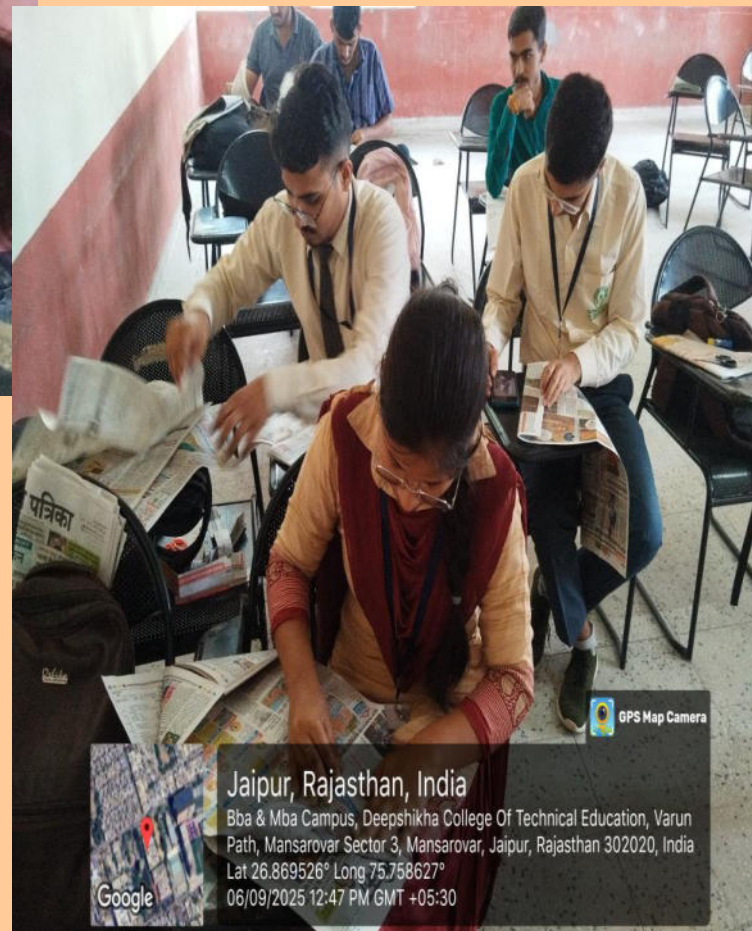
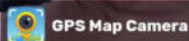
- Sheet must be of minimum A3 size***

- Paper bags must look attractive , creative and beautiful.***





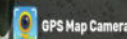
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 GPS Map Camera
