Agenda 1: Welcome Address and Confirmation of Previous Meeting Minutes

Discussion Points

Discussion Points

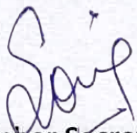
- Members appreciated the cooperation of students and faculty in maintaining a peaceful academic atmosphere.
