OBJECTIVES

The Green Campus Policy aims to:

- Minimise waste generation and promote responsible waste management practices.
- Reduce the use of single-use plastics and encourage eco-friendly alternatives.
- Increase green cover through plantation and landscaping initiatives.
- Foster environmental responsibility through education, research, outreach, and community engagement.

SCOPE

This policy applies to:

- All students of the College.
- Teaching and non-teaching staff.


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- Contractual employees.
- Visitors, vendors, and service providers while on the College campus.

INSTITUTIONAL COMMITMENTS

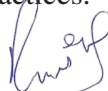
The College is committed to:

- Maintaining a clean, green, and environmentally sustainable campus.
- Promoting energy conservation through the responsible use of electricity and electrical equipment.
- Encouraging water conservation and efficient use of water resources.
- Supporting tree plantation, landscaping, and biodiversity conservation initiatives.
- Promoting paper-saving practices and encouraging digital communication wherever feasible.
- Reducing the use of single-use plastics and encouraging reusable and environmentally friendly alternatives.
- Ensuring proper segregation and scientific disposal of waste, including e-waste, in accordance with applicable guidelines.
- Encouraging sustainable transportation practices such as carpooling, cycling, walking, and the use of public transport wherever feasible.
- Complying with applicable environmental laws, regulations, and guidelines.

GREEN INITIATIVES

The College shall undertake suitable environmental initiatives, including:

- Tree plantation and campus greening programmes.
- Environmental awareness campaigns, workshops, seminars, and expert lectures.
- Celebration of World Environment Day, Earth Day, Energy Conservation Day, and other environment-related events.

- Proper management of solid waste, liquid waste, and electronic waste through environmentally responsible practices.



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ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

College Administration

The College Administration shall:

- Provide necessary support for implementing the Green Campus Policy.
- Encourage environmentally sustainable infrastructure and operational practices.
- Periodically review environmental initiatives and provide necessary resources for continuous improvement.

Green Committee / Green Club

The Green Committee shall:

- Plan, coordinate, and monitor environmental initiatives on the campus.
- Organise awareness programmes and green activities.
- Encourage participation of students and staff in environmental conservation programmes.
- Recommend measures for improving environmental performance.

Students and Staff

Students and employees are expected to:

- Maintain cleanliness within the campus.
- Use water, electricity, and other resources responsibly.
- Avoid the use of single-use plastics as far as possible.
- Participate actively in environmental awareness programmes and plantation drives.
- Follow institutional guidelines relating to environmental protection and sustainability.

WASTE MANAGEMENT

The College shall encourage:

- Segregation of biodegradable and non-biodegradable waste.
- Responsible disposal of electronic waste through authorised agencies, wherever applicable.
- Reduction, reuse, and recycling of materials wherever feasible.
- Awareness regarding responsible waste management practices.


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AWARENESS AND CAPACITY BUILDING

The College shall regularly organise:

- Environmental awareness programmes.
- Workshops, seminars, and guest lectures on sustainable development.
- Student-led green initiatives and community outreach activities.
- Campaigns promoting water conservation, energy efficiency, waste reduction, and biodiversity conservation.

MONITORING AND REVIEW

The implementation of this policy shall be monitored by the Green Committee in consultation with the Principal and IQAC.

The College shall periodically review its environmental practices and undertake Green Audit, Energy Audit, and Environment Audit, wherever applicable, to assess its environmental performance and identify opportunities for continuous improvement.

This policy shall be reviewed periodically to ensure continued compliance with the guidelines of the University Grants Commission (UGC), the University of Rajasthan, and other applicable statutory provisions.


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
